



- **Jack Nicklaus has 258 courses open for play worldwide.**
This includes 214 solo designs, 31 co-designs and 13 re-designs.
- **Nicklaus Design, as a company, has 315 courses open for play.**
The 300th Nicklaus Design to open for play was Sebonack Golf Club in Southampton, NY.
- **Nicklaus Design opened 19 courses in 2006, and expects to open 30 in 2007.**
Jack Nicklaus is involved in 27 of those 49 projects.
- **Nicklaus Design has opened 110 courses over the last seven years—an average of almost 16 courses a year—including a record 27 in 1999.**
Jack Nicklaus was involved in 92 of those 110 projects.
- **Nicklaus Design is represented in 30 countries and 38 states.**
Nicklaus Design has 191 courses open for play in the United States.
- **Nicklaus Design has 54 courses under construction, and has projects signed, under design or under development in 37 different countries.**
Of those courses under development, 65 percent are outside of the United States.
- **Nicklaus sons have been involved in 56 courses open for play.**
 1. *Jack Nicklaus II has 30 courses open for play (15 solo designs, 15 co-designs) with another seven under construction or under design worldwide.*
 2. *Steve Nicklaus has 10 courses open for play and eight under construction or design.*
 3. *Gary Nicklaus has five courses open for play and six under construction or design.*
 4. *Michael Nicklaus has three courses open for play and is featured designer on eight projects under construction or under design worldwide.*
 5. *Bill O’Leary (son-in-law) has nine courses open for play and one under construction.*
- **At least 57 Nicklaus Design courses have been ranked in various national and international Top-100 lists (*Golf Digest*, *GOLF Magazine*, and *Golfweek*).**
- **By the end of 2007, 83 Nicklaus courses will have hosted 587 professional tournaments or national amateur championships.**
Recent additions include the PGA Tour’s Las Vegas Invitational, which added Bear’s Best Las Vegas to its rotation in 2004. The Champions Tour added in 2005 the Nicklaus Golf Club at LionsGate in Overland Park, Kan. (Bayer Advantage Classic), and for 2006, Vista Vallarta Golf Club in Puerto Vallarta, Mexico (Puerto Vallarta Championship). The Nationwide Tour’s BMW Charity Pro-Am added The Cliffs at Walnut Cove in Asheville, N.C., to its course rotation for 2005.
- **Close to 40 Nicklaus Design courses in the United States have been involved in Audubon International programs.**
